PROTEST PROCEDURE

Protests may be made only on infraction of laws of tennis not facts. (Fact is what the official sees during play, law is rules of tennis) Divisioning cannot be protested.

Refer to your Special Olympics Sports Rules Book and National Governing Body Rules Book to cite the rule infraction.

The Head Coach Only completes the Protest Form and submits it to the Tournament Director no more than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match being protested.

The Sports Rules Committee will review the protest and render a decision within 1 hour.
Family, friends or athlete escorts cannot file a protest.
